April 12, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE EMPLOYERS TO INSURE THE EMPLOYERS' LIABILITY UNDER THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT THROUGH A SUBSTITUTE SYSTEM OF COMPENSATION AND INSURANCE THAT PROVIDES BENEFITS FOR INJURED EMPLOYEES THAT ARE AT LEAST EQUAL TO THOSE THAT ARE PROVIDED UNDER A STANDARD WORKERS' COMPENSATION POLICY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 97-93(a) reads as rewritten: Every employer subject to the provisions of this Article relative to the payment of compensation shall either: **(1)** Insure and keep insured his liability under this Article in any authorized corporation, association, organization, or in any mutual insurance association formed by a group of employers so authorized; or-authorized, that:

Provides a standard workers' compensation policy, or

Furnish to the Commissioner of Insurance satisfactory proof of the

employer's financial ability, either alone or through membership in a

pursuant to the provisions of G.S. 97-93.1; or

Provides a substitute system of compensation and insurance
