| 9  | (a) 'Esthetician' is any person other than a registered cosmetologist, registered          |
| 10 | apprentice, or esthetician apprentice, who practices esthetics.                            |
| 11 | (b) 'Esthetics' means providing services, for compensation, to enhance the                 |
| 12 | appearance of the face, neck, arms, legs, or shoulders of an individual through skin care, |
| 13 | makeup artistry, facials, or body waxing.  |
| 14 | (c) <u>'Esthetician apprentice' is any person who is registered by the State Board of</u>  |
| 15 | Cosmetic Art Examiners to learn the practice of esthetics under the direction and          |
| 16 | supervision of a registered cosmetologist or a registered esthetician as provided in G.S.  |
| 17 | 88-12.2. An applicant for this registration shall pay the fees required under G.S. 88-21." |
