5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Chapter 126 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
7	section to read:
8	" <u>§ 126-14.2. Political hirings limited; policy; rules.</u>
9	(a) It is the policy of this State that State departments, agencies, and institutions
10	select the most qualified persons for State government employment based upon job-
11	related qualifications of applicants for employment and not based upon political
12	affiliation, except that certain policy-making positions in State government employment
13	may be filled on bases including political affiliation where the General Assembly has
14	expressly authorized such hirings.
15	(b) The personnel policies and procedures of each State department, agency, and
16	institution shall be updated to implement the policy of nonpolitical hiring set forth in
17	subsection (a) of this section.
