SENATE BILL 1387

Short Title: Food Sanitation Funds.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT,
HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO IMPROVE THE SANITATION
PROGRAM FOR FOOD AND LODGING ESTABLISHMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of one million four hundred ninety-two thousand six hundred seventy-five dollars (\$1,492,675) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for the Department's Food, Lodging, and Institutional Sanitation Program. Funds appropriated under this section shall be allocated as follows:

(1) \$992,675 to fund the following positions and office support: five regional environmental health supervisors, two environmental engineers I, one environmental engineer II, two office assistants III, and one information process assistant.

(2) \$500,000 for aid-to-counties to support the continuing education and training of persons who conduct food and lodging inspections for county departments of health.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
