A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION AND THE FINANCING,  
2 WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF CERTAIN  
3 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT  
4 INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND THE  
5 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA HOSPITALS AT CHAPEL HILL.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. The purpose of this act is to authorize the construction by certain  
9 constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the University of North  
10 Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, of the capital improvements projects listed in the act  
11 for the respective institutions, and authorize the financing of these projects with funds  
12 available to the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, including patient receipts at the  
13 University of North Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill, self-liquidating indebtedness, or  
14 other funds, or any combination of these funds, but not including funds appropriated from  
15 the General Fund of the State.

16 Sec. 2. The capital improvements projects authorized by this act to be  
17 constructed and financed as provided in Section 1 of this act are as follows:

31 Sec. 3. At the request of The University of North Carolina Board of Governors  
32 and upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so, the Director of the  
33 Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the scope of or a change in the method  
34 of funding the project authorized by this act. In making a determination of whether to  
35 authorize a change in scope or funding, the Director of the Budget may consult with the  
36 Advisory Budget Commission. In no event may appropriations from the General Fund be  
37 used for a project authorized by this act.

38 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
