A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE RESTRICTIONS ON DEALINGS WITH SOUTH AFRICA NOW THAT THE POLICIES OF THAT COUNTRY HAVE CHANGED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115C-49 is repealed.

Sec. 2. G.S. 147-69.2(c) is repealed.

Sec. 3. G.S. 153A-141 is repealed.

Sec. 4. G.S. 160A-197 is repealed.

Sec. 5. Chapters 446 and 1070 of the Session Laws of 1987 are repealed.

Sec. 6. This act is effective upon ratification.
