2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR CIVIL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE
3	GASOLINE AND OIL INSPECTION LAW, THE MEAT INSPECTION LAW,
4	AND THE ANIMAL WELFARE AND ANIMAL HEALTH LAWS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	PART I. GASOLINE AND OIL INSPECTION ACT.
7	Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter 119 of the General Statutes is amended by
8	adding the following new section:
9	" <u>§ 119-39.1. Civil Penalties.</u>
10	The Commissioner of Agriculture may assess a civil penalty of not more than five
11	thousand dollars (\$5,000) against any person who violates a provision of this Article or
12	any rule promulgated thereunder. In determining the amount of the penalty, the
13	Commissioner shall consider the degree and extent of harm caused by the violation."
14	PART II. MEAT INSPECTION LAWS.
15	Sec. 2. G.S. 106-549.35 is amended by adding the following new subsection:
16	"(c) <u>The Director of the Meat and Poultry Inspection Service may assess a civil</u>
17	penalty of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) against any person who violates a
18	provision of this Article or Article 49B, or any rule promulgated thereunder. In
19	determining the amount of the penalty, the Director shall consider the degree and extent
20	of harm caused by the violation."

35	not expand, limit, or define the text of this act.
36	Sec. 14. This act is effective upon ratification and shall apply to violations
37	occurring on or after that date.
