Referred to: Children and Human Resources March 8, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TIME REQUIREMENT FOR THE UPDATING OF THE PLAN FOR SERVING OLDER ADULTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 143B-181.1A(a) reads as rewritten: The Division of Aging, Department of Human Resources shall submit a regularly updated plan to the General Assembly by March 1 of every other odd-numbered year. Beginning March 1, 1991, a summary plan for serving older adults shall be submitted but the full plan only for 1991 shall be submitted to the General Assembly by July 1, 1991. year, beginning March 1, 1995. This plan shall include: **(1)** A detailed analysis of the needs of older adults in North Carolina, based on existing available data, including demographic, geographic, health, social, economical, and other pertinent indicators; A clear statement of the goals of the State's long-term public policy on (2) aging; An analysis of services currently provided and an analysis of additional (3) services needed: and Specific implementation recommendations on expansion and funding of **(4)**

current and additional services and services levels."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
