2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE TAKING OF NONGAME FISH WITH BOW AND
3 ARROW UNDER AUTHORITY OF OTHER HUNTING AND FISHING
4 LICENSES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 113-275 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

7 "(k) A person may use a bow and arrow to take nongame fish in inland and joint
8 fishing waters subject to any applicable rule of the Wildlife Resources Commission
9 regarding seasons, creel limits, type of weapon or subsidiary gear, or any other restriction
10 necessary for the conservation of wildlife under the authority of the following licenses:

11 (1) All of the combination hunting and fishing licenses issued pursuant to
12 G.S. 113-270.1C;

13 (2) All of the sportsman licenses issued pursuant to G.S. 113-270.1D;

14 (3) The hunting licenses issued pursuant to G.S. 113-270.2(c)(1), (2), (3),
15 (5), and (6);

16 (4) The hook-and-line fishing licenses issued pursuant to G.S. 113-
17 271(d)(1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (8), and (9); and

- 1 (5) All of the special device fishing licenses issued pursuant to G.S. 113-
2 272.2."
3 Sec. 2. G.S. 113-272.2(d) is repealed.
4 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
