1 AN ACT TO PERMIT THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM TO REGULATE BY
2 ORDINANCE THE POSSESSION OF MALT BEVERAGES AND UNFORTIFIED
3 WINE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 18B-300(c) reads as rewritten:

7 "(c) Local Ordinance. – A city or county may by ~~ordinance regulate ordinance~~:

8 (1) Regulate or prohibit the consumption of malt beverages and unfortified
9 wine on the public streets in that city or county and on property owned
10 or occupied by that city or ~~county~~ county;

11 (2) Regulate or prohibit the possession of open containers of malt beverages
12 and unfortified wine on public streets in that city or county and on
13 property owned or occupied by that city or county; and

14 (3) Regulate or prohibit the possession of malt beverages and unfortified
15 wine on public streets, alleys, or parking lots which are temporarily
16 closed to regular traffic for special events."

17 Sec. 2. This act applies only to the City of Winston-Salem.

18 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
