A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE DESIGNATED LEGISLATIVE MEMBERSHIP OF THE  
COMMITTEE ON EMPLOYEE HOSPITAL AND MEDICAL BENEFITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 135-38(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) The Committee on Employee Hospital and Medical Benefits shall consist of 12 members as follows:

(1) The President Pro Tempore of the ~~Senate~~; Senate or a designee thereof;

(2) The Majority Leader of the Senate;

(3) The Chairman of the Senate Committee on Appropriations;

(5) A Cochairman of the Senate Committee on Finance designated by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

(6) Two other members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

(11) Six members of the House appointed by the Speaker."

Sec. 2. G.S. 135-38(a) as rewritten by Section 1 of this act reads as rewritten:

"(a) The Committee on Employee Hospital and Medical Benefits shall consist of 12 members as follows:

(1) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate or a designee thereof;

(2) ~~The Majority Leader of the Senate~~;

- 1           ~~(3) The Chairman of the Senate Committee on Appropriations;~~  
2           ~~(5) A Cochairman of the Senate Committee on Finance designated by the~~  
3           ~~President Pro Tempore of the Senate;~~  
4           ~~(6) Two other members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro~~  
5           ~~Tempore of the Senate; and~~  
6           ~~(11) Six members of the House appointed by the Speaker.~~  
7           (2a) The Speaker of the House of Representatives or a designee thereof;  
8           (3a) Five members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore of  
9           the Senate; and  
10          (4a) Five members of the House of Representatives appointed by the  
11          Speaker."

12           Sec. 3. Section 1 of this act is effective upon ratification. Section 2 of this act  
13 applies with respect to appointments made for terms beginning July 1, 1995, and  
14 thereafter.
