The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G. S. 97-88.2(b) reads as rewritten: The Commission shall refer all cases of suspected fraud and all violations related to workers' compensation claims, by or against insurers or self-funded employers, to the Department of Insurance to: shall: Perform investigations regarding all cases of suspected fraud and all (1) violations related to workers' compensation claims, by or against insurers or self-funded employers, and refer possible criminal violations to the appropriate prosecutorial authorities; Conduct administrative violation proceedings; and (2) Assess and collect penalties and restitution." (3) Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
