The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to be used as grants to the multijurisdictional drug task forces operating in Beaufort, Bertie, Bladen, Chowan, Columbus, Craven, Cumberland, Duplin, Edgecombe, Gates, Greene, Halifax, Hertford, Jones, Lenoir, Martin, Nash, New Hanover, Northampton, Pasquotank, Pender, Perquimans, Pitt, Tyrrell, Vance, Warren, Washington, Wayne, and Wilson Counties. Only local units of government shall be eligible to receive grants which shall be awarded pursuant to guidelines adopted by the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety. A minimum cash match of twenty-five percent (25%) shall be required.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
