BILL SUMMARY: Amendment defines dairy operator as the owner or operator of an animal operation involving 100 or more confined cattle. Also amends Part V of the bill dealing with the Agriculture Cost Share Program. The third edition of Senate Bill 1217 raises the maximum amount of cost share funds that may be allocated to an applicant from \$15,000 per year to \$75,000 per year. The amendment retains the current \$15,000 per year maximum for all applicants except dairy operators. Under this amendment, only operators who are dairy operators are eligible to receive a maximum of \$75,000 per year.
