A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO LIMIT THE AUTHORIZATION FOR PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS FROM 3 EMPLOYEES' SALARIES TO EMPLOYEES' ORGANIZATIONS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. G.S. 143-3.3(g) reads as rewritten: Payroll Deduction for Payments to Certain Employees' Associations Allowed. 6 "(g) - An employee of the State or any of its institutions, departments, bureaus, agencies or 7 commissions, or any of its local boards of education or community colleges, or a 8 noncertified employee of local boards of education, who is a member of a domiciled 9 employees' association that has at least 2,000 members, the majority of whom are 10 employees of the State or public school employees, State, may authorize, in writing, the 11 periodic deduction each payroll period from the employee's salary or wages a designated 12 lump sum to be paid to the employees' association. The authorization shall remain in 13 effect until revoked by the employee. A plan of payroll deductions pursuant to this 14 subsection for employees of the State and other association members shall become void if 15 the employees' association engages in collective bargaining with the State, any political 16 subdivision of the State, or any local school administrative unit. This subsection does not 17 apply to county or municipal governments or any local governmental unit, except for 18 local boards of education." 19 20 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
