A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CENTRAL CHILDREN'S HOME OF
2 NORTH CAROLINA, INC., FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Central
6 Children's Home of North Carolina, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two million
7 five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to provide better
8 services to homeless and neglected children. These funds may be used for capital
9 improvements including the following:

- 10 (1) Renovating Shepherd Hall, the Center's dining hall and auditorium;
11 (2) Constructing an emergency care cottage for girls, which can also be
12 used as a transitional living facility;
13 (3) Paving and curbing driveways and parking lots, along with related
14 landscaping; and
15 (4) Bringing all existing facilities up to current building code standards.

16 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
