1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE GRASSROOTS SCIENCE MUSEUM 3 COLLABORATIVE BY THE MUSEUM OF NATURAL SCIENCES TO 4 IMPROVE STATE PROGRAMS IN SCIENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL 5 EDUCATION. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of two million six hundred 8 thousand dollars (\$2,600,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of two million six 9 hundred thousand dollars (\$2,600,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to fund the Grassroots 10 Science Museum Collaborative (GSMC). 11 12 The GSMC is administered by the State Museum of Natural Sciences and (b)The

provides a forum to strengthen science and technology centers in the State. The membership in the Grassroots Science Museum Collaborative shall be determined and funds shall be distributed by a process developed by the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources with consultation with the Grassroots Science Museums which allocates fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to each Grassroots Science Museum and an additional percentage based on the operating budget of each museum.
