2	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE CONSTRUCTION OF (1) NEW ANIMAL WASTE
3	MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS THAT MUST BE PERMITTED AND (2)
4	EXPANSIONS OF SUCH EXISTING SYSTEMS IN A LOCATION THAT IS
5	SUBJECT TO FLOODING BY A ONE-HUNDRED-YEAR FLOOD.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. G.S. 143-215.10C(b) reads as rewritten:
8	"(b) An animal waste management system shall be designed, constructed, and
9	operated so that the animal operation served by the animal waste management system
10	does not cause pollution in the waters of the State except as may result because of rainfall
11	from a storm event more severe than the 25-year, 24-hour storm. No animal waste
12	management system for which a permit is required under this section shall be constructed
13	on land that is subject to flooding by a 100-year flood."
14	Section 2. This section is effective when it becomes law and applies to new
15	animal waste management systems for which construction commences on or after that
16	date and to expansions of such existing systems for which construction commences on or
17	after that date.
