1 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 1997 GENERAL ASSEMBLY,
2 REGULAR SESSION 1998, TO CONSIDER A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT
3 TO INCREASE OR ESTABLISH CRIMINAL AND CIVIL PENALTIES FOR
4 THE OFFENSES OF SELLING DRUGS TO A MINOR, HIRING OR
5 INTENTIONALLY USING A MINOR TO COMMIT A DRUG LAW
6 VIOLATION, AND PURCHASING OR RECEIVING DRUGS FROM A MINOR.

7 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

8 Section 1. The 1997 General Assembly, Regular Session 1998, may consider
9 "A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE OR ESTABLISH CRIMINAL
10 AND CIVIL PENALTIES FOR THE OFFENSES OF SELLING DRUGS TO A
11 MINOR, HIRING OR INTENTIONALLY USING A MINOR TO COMMIT A DRUG
12 LAW VIOLATION, AND PURCHASING OR RECEIVING DRUGS FROM A
13 MINOR."

14 Section 2. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
