1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE UNIFORM FEE FOR A CERTIFIED BIRTH, DEATH,
3	OR MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 161-10(a) reads as rewritten:
6	"(a) Except as provided in G.S. 161-11.1 or 161-11.2, all fees collected under this
7	section shall be deposited into the county general fund. In the performance of his duties,
8	the register of deeds shall collect the following fees which shall be uniform throughout
9	the State:
10	(1) Instruments in General. – For registering or filing any instrument for
11	which no other provision is made by this section, whether written,
12	printed, or typewritten, the fee shall be six dollars (\$6.00) for the first
13	page, which page shall not exceed 8 1/2 inches by 14 inches, plus two
14	dollars (\$2.00), for each additional page or fraction thereof. A page
15	exceeding 8 1/2 inches by 14 inches shall be considered two pages.
16	When a document is presented for registration that consists of
17	multiple instruments, the fee shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) for each
18	additional instrument. A document consists of multiple instruments
19	when it contains two or more instruments with different legal

1		consequences or intent, each of which is separately executed and
2		acknowledged and could be recorded alone.
3	(1a)	Deeds of Trust, Mortgages, and Cancellation of Deeds of Trust and
4		Mortgages For registering or filing any deed of trust or mortgage,
5		whether written, printed, or typewritten, the fee shall be ten dollars
6		(\$10.00) for the first page, which page shall not exceed 8 1/2 inches by
7		14 inches, plus two dollars (\$2.00) for each additional page or fraction
8		thereof. A page exceeding 8 1/2 inches by 14 inches shall be considered
9		two pages.
10		When a deed of trust or mortgage is presented for registration that
11		contains one or more additional instruments, the fee shall be ten dollars
12		(\$10.00) for each additional instrument. A deed of trust or mortgage
13		contains one or more additional instruments if such additional
14		instrument or instruments has or have different legal consequences or
15		intent, each of which is separately executed and acknowledged and
16		could be recorded alone.
17		For recording records of satisfaction, or the cancellation of record by
18		any other means, of deeds of trust or mortgages, there shall be no fee.
19	(2)	Marriage Licenses For issuing a license forty dollars (\$40.00); for
20		issuing a delayed certificate with one certified copy five dollars (\$5.00);
21		and for a proceeding for correction of names in application, license or
22		certificate, with one certified copy five dollars (\$5.00).
23	(3)	Plats. – For each original or revised plat recorded nineteen dollars
24		(\$19.00); for furnishing a certified copy of a plat three dollars (\$3.00).
25	(4)	Right-of-Way Plans. – For each original or amended plan and profile
26		sheet recorded five dollars (\$5.00). This fee is to be collected from the
27		Board of Transportation.
28	(5)	Registration of Birth Certificate One Year or More after Birth For
29		preparation of necessary papers when birth to be registered in another
30		county five dollars (\$5.00); for registration when necessary papers
31		prepared in another county, with one certified copy five dollars (\$5.00);
32		for preparation of necessary papers and registration in the same county,
33		with one certified copy ten dollars (\$10.00).
34	(6)	Amendment of Birth or Death Record. – For preparation of amendment
35		and affecting correction two dollars (\$2.00).
36	(7)	Legitimations For preparation of all documents concerned with
37		legitimations seven dollars (\$7.00).
38	(8)	Certified Copies of Birth and Death Certificates and Marriage Licenses.
39		- For furnishing a certified copy of a death or birth certificate or
40		marriage license three dollars (\$3.00). five dollars (\$5.00). Provided
41		however, a Register of Deeds may issue without charge a certified Birth
42		Certificate to any person over the age of 62 years.

1	(9)	Certified Copies For furnishing a certified copy of an instrument for	
2		which no other provision is made by this section three dollars (\$3.00)	
3		for the first page, plus one dollar (\$1.00) for each additional page or	
4		fraction thereof.	
5	(10)	Comparing Copy for Certification For comparing and certifying a	
6		copy of any instrument filed for registration, when the copy is furnished	
7		by the party filing the instrument for registration and at the time of filing	
8		thereof two dollars (\$2.00).	
9	(11)	Uncertified Copies. – When, as a convenience to the public, the register	
10		of deeds supplies uncertified copies of instruments, or index pages, he	
11		may charge fees that in his discretion bear a reasonable relation to the	
12		quality of copies supplied and the cost of purchasing and maintaining	
13		copying and/or computer equipment. These fees may be changed from	
14		time to time, but the amount of these fees shall at all times be	
15		prominently posted in his office.	
16	(12)	Notarial Acts For taking an acknowledgment, oath, or affirmation or	
17		performing any other notarial act the maximum fee set in G.S. 10A-10.	
18		This fee shall not be charged if the act is performed as a part of one of	
19		the services for which a fee is provided by this subsection; except that	
20		this fee shall be charged in addition to the fees for registering, filing, or	
21		recording instruments or plats as provided by subdivisions (1) and (3) of	
22		this subsection.	
23	(13)	Uniform Commercial Code Such fees as are provided for in Chapter	
24		25, Article 9, Part 4, of the General Statutes.	
25	(14)	Torrens Registration. – Such fees as are provided in G.S. 43-5.	
26	(15)	Master Forms. – Such fees as are provided for instruments in general.	
27	(16)	Probate For certification of instruments for registration as provided in	
28		G.S. 47-14 two dollars (\$2.00).	
29	(17)	Qualification of Notary Public For administering the oaths of office	
30		to a notary public and making the appropriate record entries as provided	
31		in G.S. 10A-8 five dollars (\$5.00).	
32	(18)	Reinstatement of Articles of Incorporation For filing reinstatements	
33		of Articles of Incorporation prepared pursuant to G.S. 105-232; such	
34		fees as provided for instruments in general. The fee shall be paid by the	
35		corporation affected."	
36	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
