February 5, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE TRAINING FOR BUILDING CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS IN THE INSPECTION AND REVIEW OF EXISTING BUILDINGS AND HISTORIC STRUCTURES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The Department of Insurance, Engineering Division, shall conduct training of Code-enforcement officials in the renovation of old and historic structures, federal standards imposed for rehabilitation of historic buildings, and the use of Volume IX of the North Carolina Building Code dealing with existing buildings. Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Insurance, Engineering Division, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to implement the provisions of this act. Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
