5	Sectio	n 1. The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to continue its
6	study of ways to	encourage the revitalization of downtown areas. This study may include
7	the following:	
8	(1)	Tax credits and incentives to encourage commercial and residential
9		investments in downtown areas, including the use of enterprise zones.
10	(2)	A constitutional amendment to allow counties and cities to provide
11		reduced property tax values and lower property tax rates for property
12		located in a downtown area.
13	(3)	Tax increment financing.
14	(4)	Increased local input in ABC licensing decisions.
15	(5)	Regulation of abandoned buildings.
16	(6)	The role of municipalities in the future needs of the State.
17	Sectio	n 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
