A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE STATE ADULT DAY CARE PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Social Services, the sum of one million six hundred fifty-five thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$1,655,750) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and two million one hundred seventy-one thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$2,171,750) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to provide funds for the State Adult Day Care Program.

Section 2. These funds shall be allocated for the following purposes:

- (1) To provide funds for start-up grants to establish 10 new adult day care programs in the 1997-98 fiscal year and 10 new adult day care programs in the 1998-99 fiscal year in the 49 counties currently without adult day care programs;
- (2) To provide funds to support the conversion of five adult day care programs into adult day health programs in the 1997-98 fiscal year and

2 programs in the 1998-99 fiscal year;
- 3 (3) To provide allocations to counties to purchase 86 slots in the new adult
4 day care programs established through the start-up grants provided
5 under subdivision (1) above in fiscal year 1997-98, to continue to
6 purchase those 86 slots in fiscal year 1998-99, and to purchase an
7 additional 86 slots for the new adult day care programs established
8 through the start-up grants provided under subdivision (1) above in
9 fiscal year 1998-99; and
- 10 (4) To provide allocations to 19 counties with adult day care programs not
11 currently receiving allocations to purchase slots in those counties.
- 12 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
