Section 1. G.S. 55B-14(c) reads as rewritten:

- A professional corporation may also be formed by and between or among: "(c)
 - A licensed psychologist and a physician practicing psychiatry to render (1) psychotherapeutic and related services; services.
 - Any combination of a registered nurse, nurse practitioner, certified (2) clinical specialist in psychiatric and mental health nursing, certified nurse midwife, and certified nurse anesthetist, to render nursing and related services that the respective stockholders are licensed, certified, or otherwise approved to provide; provide.
 - (3) A physician and a physician assistant who is licensed, registered, or otherwise certified under Chapter 90 of the General Statutes to render medical and related services; services.
 - A physician practicing psychiatry, or a licensed psychologist, or both, (4) and a certified clinical specialist in psychiatric and mental health nursing, or a certified clinical social worker, or both, to render

1		psychotherapeutic and related services that the respective stockholders
2		are licensed, certified, or otherwise approved to provide; provide.
3	(5)	A physician and any combination of a nurse practitioner, certified
4		clinical specialist in psychiatric and mental health nursing, or certified
5		nurse midwife, registered or otherwise certified under Chapter 90 of the
6		General Statutes, to render medical and related services that the
7		respective stockholders are licensed, certified, or otherwise approved to
8		provide; and-provide.
9	(6)	A physician practicing anesthesiology and a certified nurse anesthetist
10		to render anesthesia and related medical services that the respective
11		stockholders are licensed, certified, or otherwise approved to provide.
12	<u>(7)</u>	A physician and an audiologist who is licensed under Article 22 of
13		Chapter 90 of the General Statutes to render audiological and related
14		medical services that the respective stockholders are licensed, certified,
15		or otherwise approved to provide."
