A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW EXHIBIT AT THE NORTH CAROLINA MUSEUM OF LIFE AND SCIENCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The North Carolina Museum of Life and Science, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for planning, designing, and constructing a one-

of-a-kind outdoor science exhibit called BioQuest. The exhibit will provide a unique

educational opportunity to museum visitors by enabling them to observe animals and

plants in their natural environment through interactive exhibits. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
