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day care center. Duration of the service period may extend beyond a year." Section 2. The Division of Aging of the Department of Health and Human Services shall report to the North Carolina Study Commission on Aging no later than October 1, 1999, the impact on Respite Care Program services and funds of the repeal of the statutory limitation on the reimbursement rate for out-of-home placement which limits reimbursement to the current adult care reimbursement rate.

Program funds may provide no more than the current adult care reimbursement rate for

out of home placement. An out of home placement is defined as placement in a hospital,

skilled or intermediate nursing facility, adult care home, adult day health center, or adult

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and expires July 1, 2000.
