**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO EXEMPT FORSYTH COUNTY FROM CERTAIN STATUTORY  
REQUIREMENTS IN THE RENOVATION OF FORMER TOBACCO  
FACTORIES FOR COUNTY GOVERNMENT OFFICES, PARKING, AND  
RELATED FACILITY NEEDS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 143-128, 143-129, 143-131, and 143-132, Forsyth County may enter into contracts for the renovation of former tobacco factories for County government offices, parking, and related facility needs in the manner and upon the terms and conditions Forsyth County considers appropriate.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and expires June 30, 2001.
