S 1 SENATE BILL 169* Short Title: Env. Tech. Corrections. (Public) Sponsors: Senator Albertson. Referred to: Agriculture/Environment/Natural Resource. February 17, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE CLARIFYING, CONFORMING, AND TECHNICAL CHANGES TO VARIOUS LAWS RELATING TO ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 143B-282(a) reads as rewritten: There is hereby created the Environmental Management Commission of the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources with the power and duty to promulgate rules to be followed in the protection, preservation, and enhancement of the water and air resources of the State. Within the limitations of G.S. 143-215.9 concerning industrial health and safety, the Environmental Management Commission shall have all of the following powers and duties: To grant a permit or temporary permit, to modify or revoke a permit, and to refuse to grant permits pursuant to G.S. 143-215.1 and G.S. 143-215.108 with regard to controlling sources of air and water pollution: pollution. To issue a special order pursuant to G.S. 143-215.2(b) and G.S. b.

143-215.110 to any person whom the Commission finds

12	from the Cooperative Extension Service, shall establish the record-keeping requirements
13	under G.S. 143-215.1C(e)(8), 143-215.10C(e)(8), as enacted by Section 2 of this act. The
14	Natural Resources Conservation Service is encouraged to cooperate fully with
15	establishing these requirements."
16	Section 3. Section 2 of Chapter 627 of the 1995 Session Laws (1996 Regular
17	Session) reads as rewritten:
18	"Sec. 2. G.S. 113-133(e) <u>113-133.1(e)</u> is amended by deleting the words
19	'Currituck: Session Laws 1959, Chapter 545.'"
20	Section 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
