A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ASSIST APPROVED CHARTER 3 SCHOOLS TO MEET THEIR START-UP COSTS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Education the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 6 1997-98 fiscal year for the State Board to establish and implement a program that 7 provides grants or loans to charter schools for whom charters are approved. The State 8 Board shall determine the amount of each grant or loan; however, no charter school shall 9 receive more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). Each grant or loan shall be used 10 during the first year after the charter has been approved. The grant or loan shall be used 11 for one-time costs or expenses related to starting the school. 12 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997. 13
