March 5, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE PROGRAM. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to improve services for students with limited English proficiency. The State Board of Education shall allocate these funds to local school administrative units with a high percentage of students for whom English is a second language. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
