6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. G.S. 131D-10.6A is repealed.
8	Section 2. Chapter 131D of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
9	section to read:
10	"§ 131D-10.3B. Training and continuing education of foster parents and certain
11	foster care and adoption social workers required.
12	(a) Foster parents shall complete a minimum of 30 hours of preservice training
13	either prior to licensure, or within six months from the date a provisional license is issued
14	pursuant to G.S. 131D-10.3(f). Foster parents shall complete a minimum of 10 hours of
15	continuing education every year.
16	(b) Foster care and adoption social workers shall complete a minimum of 84 hours
17	of preservice training within six months of assuming the duties of a foster care or

- adoption social workers employed by county departments of social services shall
 complete a minimum of 18 hours of continuing education every year.
- 3 (c) The Department of Human Resources shall provide for in-house training to 4 ensure that the requirements of this section are met."
- 5 Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
