A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW GOVERNING THE PROCEDURE FOR ENTRY OF
ORDERS IN THE COMMODITIES ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 78D-30(d) reads as rewritten:

"(d) If no hearing is requested request for a hearing or other responsive pleading or submission is received by the Administrator within 30 business days of service of notice under subsection (b) of this section and ~~none~~ no hearing is ordered by the Administrator, the summary order will automatically become a final order after 30 business ~~days~~ days from the date of entry of the order."

Section 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1997, and applies to administrative proceedings commenced on or after that date.
