Section 1. G.S. 1-567.31(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) The provisions of this Article Article, except G.S. 1-567.38 and G.S. 1-567.39, G.S. 1-567.39, and 1-567.65, apply only if the place of arbitration is in this State."

Section 2. G.S. 1-567.48 reads as rewritten:

# "§ 1-567.48. Equal treatment of parties: representation by attorney.

- (a) The parties shall be treated with equality and each party shall be given a full opportunity to present its case.
- 17 (b) A party has the right to be represented by an attorney at any proceeding or hearing under this Article. A waiver of this right prior to the proceeding or hearing is ineffective."

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to proceedings initiated on or after that date.
