1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL HEALTH EDUCATION
2	PROGRAM TO PROVIDE INSTRUCTION ON THE PERFORMANCE OF
4	CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AND THE HEIMLICH MANEUVER.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 115C-81(e1)(1) reads as rewritten:
7	"(e1) School Health Education Program to Be Developed and Administered.
8	(1) A comprehensive school health education program shall be developed
9	and taught to pupils of the public schools of this State from kindergarten
10	through ninth grade. This program includes age-appropriate instruction
11	in the following subject areas, regardless of whether this instruction is
12	described as, or incorporated into a description of, 'family life
13	education', 'family health education', 'health education', 'family living',
14	'health', 'healthful living curriculum', or 'self-esteem':
15	a. Mental and emotional health;
16	b. Drug and alcohol abuse prevention;

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- 1 Nutrition; c. 2 d. Dental health: 3 Environmental health; e. 4 Family living; f 5 Consumer health: g. 6 h. Disease control; 7 Growth and development; i. First aid and emergency care; care, including the teaching of 8 j. 9 cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the Heimlich maneuver 10 by using hands-on training with mannequins so that students become proficient in order to pass a test approved by the 11 12 American Heart Association. Preventing sexually transmitted diseases, including Acquired 13 k. 14 Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) virus infection, and other 15 communicable diseases; 16 1. Abstinence until marriage education; and 17 m. Bicycle safety." 18 Section 2. G.S. 115C-81(c) reads as rewritten: (For effective date see notes) Local boards of education shall provide for the 19 "(c) 20 efficient teaching at appropriate grade levels of all materials set forth in the standard 21 course of study, including integrated instruction in the areas of citizenship in the United States of America, government of the State of North Carolina, government of the United 22 23 States, fire prevention, the free enterprise system, system, and the dangers of harmful or 24 illegal drugs, including alcohol, and cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the Heimlich 25 maneuver. alcohol. Except when a board authorizes teaching in a foreign language in order to comply 26 27 with federal law, local boards of education shall require all teachers and principals to conduct classes except foreign language classes in English. Any teacher or principal who 28
- 29 refuses to do so may be dismissed."
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Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
