S 1 SENATE BILL 51\* Short Title: Adult Day Care Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Martin of Pitt, Cochrane, Dannelly, Carpenter; Forrester and Hoyle. Referred to: Appropriations. February 6, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE STATE ADULT DAY CARE PROGRAM. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Social Services, the sum of three hundred fifty-six thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$356,250) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and three hundred fifty-six thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$356,250) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to provide funds for the State Adult Day Care Program. Section. 2. These funds shall be allocated for the following purposes: To provide funds for start-up grants to establish 10 new adult day care (1) programs in the 1997-98 fiscal year and 10 new adult day care programs in the 1998-99 fiscal year in the 49 counties currently without adult day care programs; and To provide funds to support the conversion of five adult day care (2) programs into adult day health programs in the 1997-98 fiscal year and the conversion of five adult day care programs into adult day health programs in the 1998-99 fiscal year.

Section. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
