A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE A

"SCENIC RIVERS" REGISTRATION PLATE WITH THE NET PROCEEDS

FROM THE SALE OF THE PLATES TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE CLEAN WATER MANAGEMENT TRUST FUND.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision in the appropriate alphabetical order to read:

"(22a1) Scenic Rivers. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the words 'Scenic Rivers' and a picture representing the unique beauty of the scenic rivers of North Carolina."

Section 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

Section 3. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), and the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, as follows:

Section 4. G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(<u>b5</u>) <u>Scenic Rivers Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a scenic rivers plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of scenic rivers plates to the Clean Water Management Trust Fund established in G.S. 113-45.3."</u>

Section 5. This act is effective when it becomes law.
