A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RURAL COMMUNITY FIRE

PROTECTION PROGRAM IN THE DIVISION OF FOREST RESOURCES,
DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

Whereas, the Rural Community Fire Protection Program in the Division of Forest Resources, Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources has provided funding, surplus government fire trucks, firefighting equipment, and training to the rural fire departments of North Carolina since 1970; and

Whereas, the Division of Forest Resources has assisted rural volunteer fire departments with training and emergency response equipment and vehicles; and

Whereas, in 1997, the United States Department of Agriculture reduced available federal funding such that the Rural Community Fire Protection Program is no longer efficient or able to provide adequate support to the rural volunteer fire departments in North Carolina; Now, therefore,

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 7 Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of one hundred thousand dollars 8 (\$100,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars 9 (\$100,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for the Rural Community Fire Protection Program 10 in the Division of Forest Resources. These funds shall be used only for this Program.

- These funds may be used for administrative and operating costs of the Program and may 1
- 2 be distributed as grants to rural fire departments in North Carolina pursuant to the 3 Program. 4
  - Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
