Referred to: Appropriations. April 17, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA TRANSPORTATION MUSEUM LOCATED IN SPENCER. Whereas, the North Carolina Transportation Museum needs funds for repairs, renovation, and preservation of the historic Back Shop for future expansion of the museum to interpret all modes of transportation; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, the sum of three million one hundred thousand dollars (\$3,100,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for capital improvements at the North Carolina Transportation Museum (Historic Spencer Shops). Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
