HOUSE BILL 1286 RATIFIED BILL

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE EXEMPTION FROM THE "MASS GATHERINGS" STATUTE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 130A-252(b), as amended by Section 1 of S.L. 1999-3, reads as rewritten:

"(b) The provisions of this Part do not apply to <u>a permanent stadiums stadium</u> with <u>an</u> adjacent <u>campgrounds campground</u> that <u>host hosts an</u> annual <u>events attracting</u> <u>event that has, within the previous five years, attracted crowds in excess of 70,000 people. The term 'stadium' includes speedways and dragways."</u>

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
