April 20, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RESTORE AND RENOVATE THE MATTHEWS COMMUNITY CENTER AND EXPAND ITS STAGE AREA. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Matthews in Mecklenburg County the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to restore and renovate and expand the stage area of the old Matthews School, which is now used as a community center. The improvements will assist in preserving the heritage of the school and provide the community with a facility for various activities, including meetings and cultural programs.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
