A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EDUCATION CENTER AT THE CONTEMPORARY ART MUSEUM IN THE CITY OF RALEIGH. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Contemporary Art
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Contemporary Art Museum, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars

Museum, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the Education Center at the Contemporary Art Museum in the City of Raleigh. The Center will house the Art Institute for Educators which will serve the needs of art educators statewide in North Carolina's public schools, contain a preschool with a visual art focus for children from Wake County, and conduct educational programs designed for middle and high school students from across the State

of North Carolina.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
