Section 1. The Charter of the City of Charlotte, being Chapter 713 of the 1965 Session Laws, as amended, is amended by adding the following new section to Subchapter E of Chapter IX:

"Section 9.84. Transit Procurements. In addition to other authorized methods of procurement, the City of Charlotte may contract for the purchase, lease, or other acquisition of any apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment for public transit purposes using the competitive proposal method provided in G.S. 143-129(h)."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
