May 24, 2000 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ALLOCATE ADDITIONAL RESOURCES TO LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS EXPERIENCING A LOSS OF STUDENTS TO CHARTER SCHOOLS BUT AN DAILY AVERAGE **MEMBERSHIP** OVERALL INCREASE IN NONCHARTER SCHOOLS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The State Board of Education shall use funds from the Reserve for Increases in Average Daily Membership to allocate additional resources to local school administrative units experiencing a loss of students to charter schools but an overall increase in average daily membership in noncharter schools. The State Board shall report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee on resources allocated pursuant to the provisions of this act.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
