5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Charter of the City of Durham, being Chapter 671 of the 1975
7	Session Laws, as amended, is amended by adding a new section to read:
8	"Section 84.4. Anti-Sweatshop Requirements. (a) The City Council may
9	establish, agree to, and comply with anti-sweatshop requirements by including the
10	requirements in the specifications for contracts to purchase or rent apparel or textiles and
11	awarding bids pursuant to G.S. 143-129 and G.S. 143-131, if applicable, to the lowest
12	responsible bidders meeting these and other specifications. Anti-sweatshop requirements
13	may include:
14	(1) Prohibitions against violations of applicable law or regulation, forced
15	labor, or employment of children; and
16	(2) The disclosure of:
17	a. The locations and ownership of the manufacturing company
18	where the apparel or textiles are made, finished, packed, or
19	otherwise processed;

1	b. <u>Compensation to workers; and</u>
2	c. Any other information necessary and proper for the enforcement
3	of other anti-sweatshop requirements and not in violation of any
4	other State law.
5	(b) The authority granted by this section is in addition to, and not in derogation of,
6	any other authority granted by this Charter or any other law."
7	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
