2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE
3	RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY THE COMPENSATION AND
4	RETENTION OF EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the salaries and
7	benefits provided to employees of the Department of Correction and examine methods
8	for improving the compensation and retention of those employees.
9	Section 2. The Legislative Research Commission may report its findings and
10	any recommendations to the 2001 General Assembly.
11	Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General
12	Assembly the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to
13	implement the study authorized in this act.
14	Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
