A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE STATE ADULT DAY CARE3 PROGRAM.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 6 Health and Human Services, Division of Aging, the sum of three hundred fifty-six 7 thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$356,250) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum 8 of three hundred fifty-six thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$356,250) for the 2000-9 2001 fiscal year for the State Adult Day Care Program. These funds shall be allocated 10 for the following purposes:

- 11 (1) To provide funds for start-up grants to establish 10 new adult day care 12 programs in the 1999-2000 fiscal year and 10 new adult day care 13 programs in the 2000-2001 fiscal year in the 49 counties currently 14 without adult day care programs; and
- 15(2)To provide funds to support the conversion of five adult day care16programs into adult day health programs in the 1999-2000 fiscal year

1	and the conversion of five adult day care programs into adult day health
2	programs in the 2000-2001 fiscal year.
3	(3) Of the funds appropriated in this section, the sum of eighty thousand
4	dollars (\$80,000) in each fiscal year shall be used to hire independent
5	consultants to provide specialized technical assistance to adult day care
6	programs.
7	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
