2	AN ACT DIRECTING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT
3	COMMITTEE TO STUDY HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION STANDARDS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall study
6	current high school graduation standards. In the course of its study, the Committee shall
7	consider:
8	(1) Whether the current course requirements are adequate given increasing
9	expectations for student academic performance;
10	(2) Whether the State should grant differentiated diplomas based on the
11	course of study completed by students, the level of student achievement,
12	or other factors; and
13	(3) Other issues related to high school graduation.
14	The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall make a final report
15	on these issues to the 1999 General Assembly, 2000 Regular Session.
16	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
