6	Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the public health	
7	issues involved in authorizing dog owners to administer animal rabies vaccine to their	
8	own dogs. The	study may include:
9	(1)	The public health consequences of allowing dog owners to administer
10		animal rabies vaccine to their own dogs.
11	(2)	The special skills needed to safely administer animal rabies vaccine and
12		whether nonveterinarians may safely administer the vaccine.
13	(3)	Analysis of current training offered by the State Public Health
14		Veterinarian to Certified Rabies Vaccinators and whether it is adequate
15		to train owners to administer animal rabies vaccine to their own dogs.
16	(4)	Whether the current cost to dog owners of rabies vaccination is a
17		deterrent to vaccination.
18	(5)	Ways to improve the current rabies vaccination system to ensure
19		maximum rabies control.
