February 11, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOUR-YEAR TERMS FOR THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CHINA GROVE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 3 of the Charter of the Town of China Grove, being Chapter 309 of the Private Laws of 1903, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3. The officers of said corporation—the town shall be a Mayor and five Aldermen, who shall be elected biennially, and whose term of office shall begin as provided in the general election law for municipal corporations, as passed by the Legislature of 1901. to four-year terms. In 1999, the two persons receiving the highest number of votes are elected to four-year terms and the three persons receiving the next highest number of votes are elected to two-year terms. In 2001, and quadrennially thereafter, three persons are elected to four-year terms. In 2003, and quadrennially thereafter, two persons are elected to four-year terms."
