| 4 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 5 | Section 1. Section 3 of the Charter of the Town of China Grove, being Chapter |
| 6 | 309 of the Private Laws of 1903, reads as rewritten: |
| 7 | "Sec. 3. The officers of said corporation the town shall be a Mayor and five |
| 8 | Aldermen, who shall be elected biennially, and whose term of office shall begin as |
| 9 | provided in the general election law for municipal corporations, as passed by the |
| 10 | Legislature of 1901. to four-year terms, except as provided otherwise in this section. |
| 11 | In 1999, and quadrennially thereafter, a Mayor shall be elected to a four-year term. |
| 12 | In 1999, for the position of Alderman, the two persons receiving the highest number |
| 13 | of votes shall be elected to four-year terms and the three persons receiving the next |
| 14 | highest number of votes shall be elected to two-year terms. In 2001, and quadrennially |
| 15 | thereafter, three persons shall be elected to four-year terms. In 2003, and quadrennially |
| 16 | thereafter, two persons shall be elected to four-year terms." |
| 17 | Section 2. This act applies beginning with persons elected in 1999. |
| 18 | Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law. |
